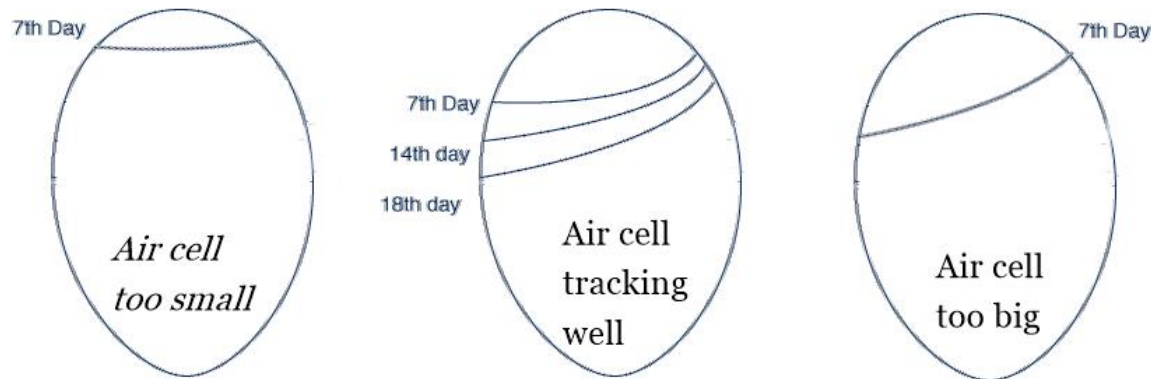


# CANDLING FOR HUMIDITY

Incubation is often seen as a mysterious process. Viewing the egg contents during incubation is called *candling*.

Candle your chicken eggs every 7 days. Hold the egg up to a candler light in a darkened room to illuminate inside the egg. Compare your egg to the air cell indicator below. The size of the air cell is crucial for the chick to hatch.



Humidity is important throughout the incubation process, not just the last 3 days prior to hatch.
